The 4th Annual IVY Reunion

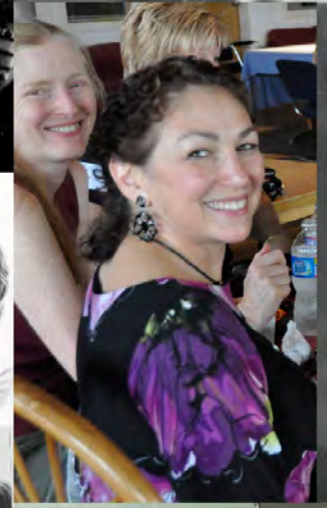
at Jozart Center for the Arts, California, PA 3:00 PM ~ 11:00 PM

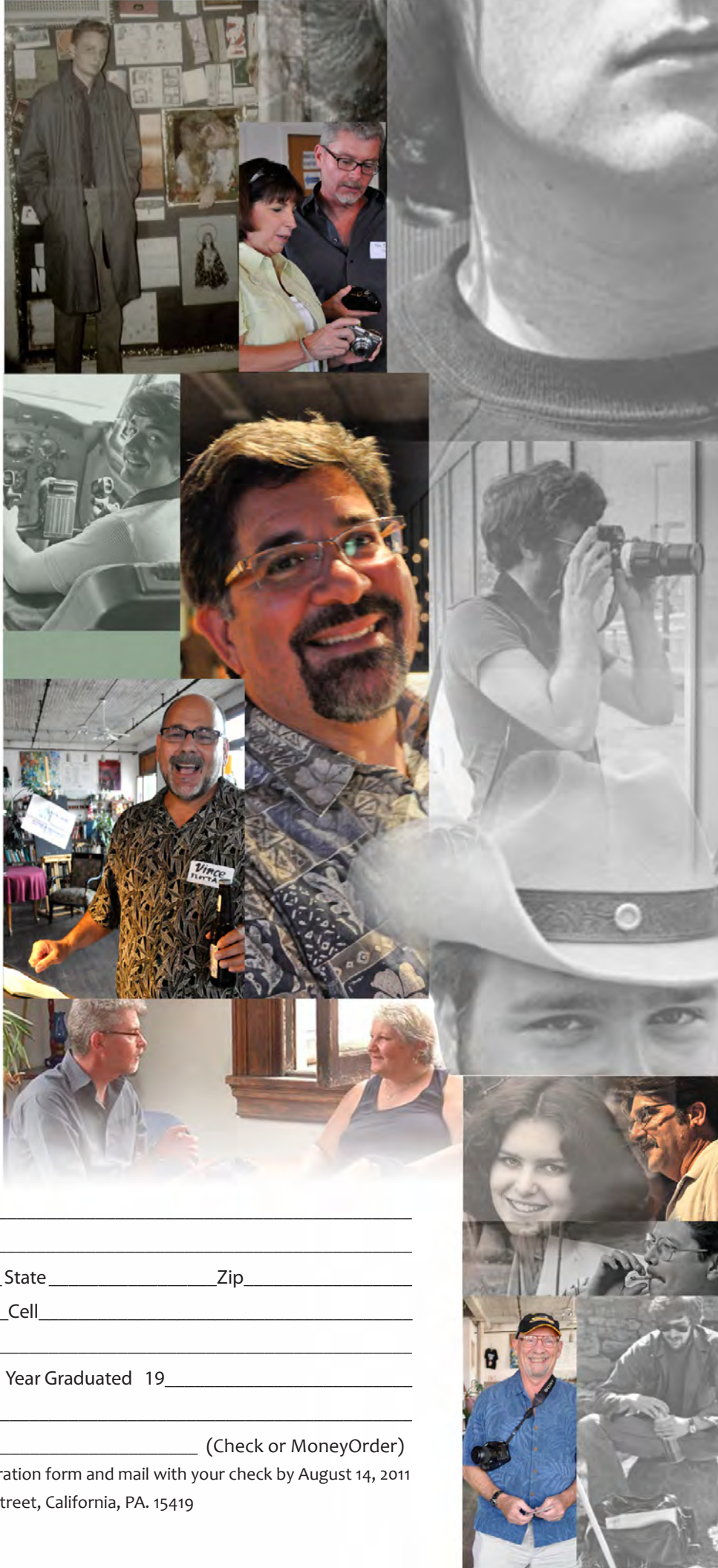

Directions to Jozart Center for the Arts in California, PA:

From Pittsburgh -
South on Route 51 to the Clairton/Jefferson Hills area.
Pick up Route 43 (Mon Fayette Expressway) South.
Cross Interstate 70 and continue South to Exit 32.
Take Exit 32 (California Exit).
Right at the end of the Exit ramp onto Malden Road.
Malden turns into Wood Street.
Continue on Wood Street (blocks are numbered 7th, 5th, etc.)
Jozart Center for the Arts is on the corner of 2nd and Wood Street.
Parking is on the street. Meters are Free on weekends.
Enter on 2nd Street and come up the stairs to the second floor.
